Excerpt from constitution regarding club cars (as amended October 2007):

Club Cars include all motor vehicles (cars, trucks, motorcycles, race cars etc.) that are at least 25 years old and are essentially as manufactured. Modifications required by law or for safety reasons such as turn signals, safety glass, seat belts, hydraulic brakes, radial tires etc. are acceptable, as are other minor changes that do not significantly alter the appearance of the vehicle. The engine need not be the original, but must be of the same type as was available on the car at time of manufacture. Major modifications such as radical suspension changes or top chops that would be difficult to change back to original are not acceptable.

Meetings are generally at 2 PM on the Second Sunday of each month, at the Headingly Community Centre, 5353 Portage Avenue (across from Nick's Inn). The MCAAC generally holds a general meeting on the second Sunday of each month at 2:00 PM at the Headingley Community Centre, 5353 Portage Avenue. Meeting time and date may vary in the summer months, check in the newsletter or with an executive member if you aren't sure.

In the summer, the club holds a variety of activities, including auto tours and outings planned for the enjoyment of families, such as the spring get-together, swap meet, corn roast, fall banquet, etc.

All members of the club receive the club's monthly publication, "The Sidemount Reporter" which records club activities and articles of interest to members.

The club maintains an extensive library of books and periodicals related to the old car hobby, including restoration guides, maintenance manuals, spotter's guides, and automobile history books. These are free for borrowing to members only.

Any person of good character who wishes to enter into the hobby and fellowship of the MCAAC may join. While the majority of our members own old cars, this is not a condition of membership. Members come from all ages and occupational groups, and everyone is welcome.
